Power Had Gone Out (revised) (Woman with the Issue of Blood)

#### I. Introduction

- A. Ill. A college student was taking his final exam in Zoology 101.
  - 1. He had not studied b/c he thought it would be a breeze.
  - 2. However, when the test was passed out, it was the picture of the legs of bird (no bodies).
  - 3. He had to give the name of the bird based solely on the picture of its leg.
- 4. In growing frustration he stared at the test for over an hour.
- 5. In anger, he walked up to the professors desk and threw the test down in front of him.
- 6. "This is the worst test I have ever taken."
- 7. Prof: "Young man, you have failed this test. What is your name?"
- 8. The student pulled up his pant leg, showed it to the professor and said: "I don't know, you tell me!"
- B. There's a whole lot of ppl who have never identified their most significant need.

II. Scripture: Mark 5:22-34

A. After Matthew and before Luke in the NT.

## III. A Woman in Trouble

- A. v. 26 says it all:
  - 1. "having a blood flow" (menstrual uncleanness) (restricted from temple; social outcast)
  - 2. Suffered from many doctors (experimentation; "practicing medicine")
  - 3. Exhausted all her wealth/money (now at a place of poverty)
  - 4. Had not improved (sick of being sick; discouragement)
  - 5. Slowly getting worse (gradual decline)
- B. Losing hope quickly: despair.
  - 1. You have neighbors who are in this position.
  - 2. ...family. ...co-workers.
  - 3. ...friends. ...hopeless.
  - 4. ...discouraged.
  - 5. Pastoral Pause: Tried everything... but Jesus.
- C. Note: Look what she does though!
- D. v. 27- "She had heard the reports about Jesus and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his garment."
  - 1. *Heard* the reports/ Word
  - 2. *Came* (observed)
  - 3. *Touched* (reached out)
- E. Pastoral Pause: Be a

- "reporter" of what Jesus is doing.
- F. **Point:** If you listen/read the Word long enough it will bring you to a point that you will either accept or reject Jesus.
  - 1. When she touched Jesus, 12 years of infirmity and misery, depression, fatigue, bleeding, loss, decline, and disease came to an end! (Instantly v 29)
  - 2. Note: There are some things God wants to do in your life right now!
- G. Then Jesus wants to know who touched Him.
  - 1. He knew power had gone out!
  - 2. He knew someone had received something from Him.
- H. The disciples= you're in a crowd Jesus!? (everyone is touching you)
- I. Note: Not everyone around Jesus touches Him like the woman touched Him.
  - 1. Not everyone reaches out in faith.
  - 2. Not everyone is desperate enough.
  - 3. Some don't even make it through the crowds!
- III. Jesus and the Woman
  - A. **Note:** Being a disciple of Christ is not only

### receiving.

- B. Jesus wants to do more than dispatch a miracle.
  - 1. More than let a power bolt out.
  - 2. Jesus wants to encounter a person whom He loves!
  - 3. Note *the danger* of hearing and coming w/out touching!
- C. **Point:** In the Kingdom of God, miracles lead to meetings!
- D. Point: Being a Christian is not about getting our perceived needs met; it is being in the presence of Jesus, being known by him, and following him.
- IV. Jesus is Healing!
- A. v.33 The woman knew what had happened.
  - 1. She knew something was different.
  - 2. There was an assurance of a life change.
  - 3. She fell at His feet!
- B. v. 34: "Daughter your faith has made you well!"
  - 1. Spoken hebrew/aramaic word is: vashaw
  - 2. It can mean 'to heal' or 'to save' depending upon context.
  - 3. Same root word as Jesus' name 'yeshua.'
- C. **Point:** In a way that the woman could not fully

know, her desire for healing was really a desire for Jesus!

- 1. And Jesus was the real healing for her.
- 2. Jesus cannot be separated from the wholeness of life in Him!

## V. Conclusion

- A. There are ppl in the world today like this woman!
- B. They are in a place where many of us use to be.
- C. They are *searching for answers*, healing, wholeness, joy, peace, etc.
- D. Note: I'll leave you with

  Jesus words to the woman:

  "Go in peace, and be
  healed of your disease."
